

World Meteorological Day 2019 Celebration in MALAYSIA



The Malaysian Meteorological Department (MMD) held its World Meteorological Day 2019 celebration on 19th March 2019 in SMK Bukit Merchu, Kuala Kangsar - a school in one of our states, PERAK.

It was officiated by the Secretary-General of the Malaysia's Ministry of Energy, Science, Technology, Environment and Climate Change (MESTECC), Datuk Seri Dr. Mohd Azhar Hj. Yahaya, witnessed by the Director General of Malaysian Meteorological Department, Datuk Alui Bahari.

Among the activities lined up in commemorating the WMD celebrations are exhibitions and competitions (colouring, public speaking and treasure hunt) related to meteorology and science. The one-day celebration was participated by more than 1,000 students from schools nearby.

The celebration was also used as a platform to launch our *Buku Iklim Perak* (Climate of Perak Book) which focuses on the weather conditions in the state of Perak with information related rainfall, temperature, humidity, wind patterns and climate change.
